

# Andy Goldsworthy Slides

## Page 1

1. Andy drawing in the sand. (Ask students if they have ever made a sand castle or drew in the sand? Is it Art?)
2. The tide comes in and washes it away.
3. Same line design carved in red dirt.
4. Mound created in beach sand.
5. The tide comes in and washes it away.
6. Spiral mound in sand.
7. Heat of Andy's hand melts a sheet of ice leaving the shape or imprint of his hand.
8. Icicles placed on a rock like spines.
9. Different view of icicles.
10. Another view of icicles.
11. Icicles melting.
12. Forming pieces of ice into curvy line.
13. Ice "cone" or "egg".
14. Ice "cone or egg" melting.
15. Icicles again.
16. Icicles arranged sticking out horizontally. (He only uses water to Make the ice stick to the rock which takes a lot of patience.)

17. Sheets of ice arranged like floating stepping stones.
18. Rock Orb “cone” with tide coming in. (A big part of the art is watching what nature will do to it over time.)
19. Rock orb “cone” with tide going out.
20. Rocks arranged in a line.
21. Colored rocks placed in a rectangle.
22. Making a rectangular snow line by shoveling snow into a mound leaving the two sides around the mound without snow.
23. As snow starts to melt the rectangular snow mound is still there. (Have you ever made a snowman and were amazed that it was still there even though all the snow on the ground around it melted?)
24. Even when it warms up the snow mound is STILL there!
25. Red leaves placed on rock with water.
26. Sticks arranged, then blown away or trampled on by cows in the field.
27. Sticks arranged to catch light at different angles creating shadows which make the sticks look like they are different colors but they are the same color stick!
28. Here are the same sticks later on in the day. See how the one in front is dark now? (Flash back and forth to the previous slide.)

29. Same concept of arranging sticks to create shadows which makes the sticks seem to change colors throughout the day as the sun changes position in the sky.
30. Yellow leaves around a rock.
31. Yellow and brown leaves.
32. Here's Andy arranging leaves.
33. Finished line of leaves and how it disappears over time.
34. The wind blows them till finally the design is gone.
35. Leaves on a stick.
36. Leaves around a stick.
37. Pile of red leaves.
38. Leaves on a rock gradually changing color from yellow to green.
39. Leaves again.
40. Leaves on a log.
41. Rainbow of leaves on water.
42. Then it gets washed away!
43. Floating rectangle of leaves. ( He connected the leaves by using thorns and sticks!)

44. "Snake" of leaves traveling on water.
45. Coiled "snake" of leaves. Watch what happens as the current carries it way...
46. It travels...
47. Down the river...
48. Until it disappears.
49. Feathers on a rock in water.
50. Feathers are washed away!
51. Leaves on a tree molded with water.
52. Mud on a tree.
53. Mud on a tree creating a hole, then it dries and falls off.
54. Andy layed down on the ground right as it started to rain then he stood up to take the picture of the dry spot where he was!
55. Same thing here but in the middle of the road!!!
