

“ Art In Nature ”

Instructions for volunteers

The students have seen Andy Goldsworthy’s work in their class and are familiar with the concept of site specific nature sculpture. Today they will team up in groups of 3 to 5 students to create an art installation using natural materials on the Duniway campus. Pass out bags for the students to gather materials. Please remind the students not to break limbs of trees and plants. It’s ok to pick a few leaves from the underside of the bushes but we do not want to harm the plants.

Take digital photos of the students with their piece and the piece by itself. Preferably one shot to capture the whole piece and one close up. If there is time they can create another piece individually.

Pose the question: What do you think will happen to your piece over time?

Things to think about

- Background color
- Using simple geometric shapes
- Concentric shapes
- Patterns
- Fields of color, differences in color
- Changes in size and color
- Texture

Natural Objects On The Duniway Campus

Woodchips	Moss on the trees
Leaves	Moss as a background
Maple tree seed pods	Daisy flowers (in the S.W. field)
Grass	Camellia leaves & buds
Sticks	Spiky tree pods (in the S.W. corner of the front of the school)

Rocks	Pine branches and Pinecones

Have buckets of water and paper cups available
